THE BEST WHITE

Morandé Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2010 Casablanca

Thanks to a superlative harvest in Casablanca, one of its most classic examples has achieved the brilliance of its best years. Reserva 2010 is a subtle yet concentrated wine, elegant in the nose, with almost floral notes, and so powerful in the mouth as to be almost astringent. It is difficult to ask more of a wine that costs so little. Pablo Morandé is the craftsman responsible for this white, intended as an aperitif, but also with potential for development in the bottle.

THE BEST SAUVIGNON BLANC

Morandé Reserva Sauvignon Blanc 2010 Casablanca

The subtlety of the aromas is almost floral, though always with a thoroughly citrus side that gives it freshness. The mouth is surprisingly strong, almost tannic and with the acidity and bitterness associated with the juice of pink grapefruit. Excellent: one of the best versions of this classic Sauvignon from Casablanca.

THE BEST ROSÉ

Morandé Pionero Rosé Cabernet Sauvignon/Syrah 2010

Deliciously juicy, this rosé is perfect for opening beside the swimming pool. Pure ripe raspberry juice.
