Edición Limitada Sauvignon Blanc 2010

This wine comes from the El Ensueño vineyard in Casablanca, which has sandy-clay soils, with low fertility, and a cold maritime climate. Clones 1 and 5 from Davis, California, are used, the first contributing aromatic intensity and the second, weight and structure.

Colour: straw yellow with a hint of gold, very brilliant.

Aroma: honey and orange-blossom, blended with white fruits, subtly toasted and elegant.

Flavour: fresh, complex taste, with some notes of grapefruit and honey and with good ageing potential due to its structure.

Food match: ideal to accompany haute cuisine seafood.
